## **Video Production Internship at the Center for Creative Conservation**

The University of Washington's Center for Creative Conservation ([conservation.uw.edu](http://conservation.uw.edu)) is seeking a student intern to create one or more short videos about our programs. The mission of the Center is to promote innovative solutions to complex environmental problems by fostering collaborations across broadly diverse disciplines and sectors. Our efforts support the sustainability of our world, encompassing biological and cultural diversity, social and ecological integrity, and matters of equity and justice.

With guidance from staff, the Video Production Intern will capture original footage, edit existing material, and create short, shareable, eye-catching videos that tell the story of the Center and its various programs. One video will tell the story of researchers and video game developers meeting to create "EarthGames" that promote environmental learning and action; another will showcase our "Nature & Health" program that is growing a network of people interested in the human health benefits of being in natural places; and a third will promote our "Climate Change Video Contest" with clips from previous winners, and info about the upcoming competition. Most likely, one intern will take on one project. Goals are to reach a wider and more diverse audience and foster support for these programs and the Center overall.

This is an unpaid internship for UW students, to be arranged for credit as part of a class project or capstone. We are seeking a student with experience in video production and digital storytelling who is passionate about the importance of effective communication for solving environmental problems, and excited to learn about a world of creative approaches to conservation and sustainability.
